After a busy dry season, we move into the quieter wet season time, but there is still quite a bit happening in Palmerston.

City of Palmerston Library recognised as the NT's first dementia friendly library

As we grow older, it's important that there are places that people feel safe, especially for those experiencing dementia themselves or family and friends of people with dementia. Dementia friendly places allow people to have places they can go which are calm, uncluttered and friendly places to visit. City of Palmerston library staff have undergone training to support people coming into the library with dementia and make it a more friendly and inclusive space for everyone.

Changes to opening hours of the Recreation Centre

The council has changed the opening hours of the Recreation Centre for members of the public without bookings. The Recreation Centre is now open to the public only from 8am to 10am on weekdays. Outside of these times, only people with scheduled bookings will be permitted into the centre. The change in opening hours allows some changes to be made. Soon there will be opportunities to book less formal meeting spaces in the foyer space of the Recreation Centre, offering more informal meeting places in our facilities, that don't require one of the larger community rooms.

Resignation of CEO Luccio Cercarelli

After nearly 7 years with the City of Palmerston, Luccio Cercarelli made the move to NTG as the CEO of Housing, Local Government and Community Development. A Palmerston local, Luccio dedicated a lot of his time to the council and residents, and will be missed. While recruitment of a new CEO is underway, we have appointed Amelia Vellar as our Interim CEO. Amelia has been the Deputy CEO for roughly 4 years and has a good knowledge of council's operations.

Christmas Wonderland

Once again, this year, a favourite of Palmerston residents and those living beyond is Christmas Wonderland. We will be offering 8 evenings of activities in Goyder Square, the library and Recreations Centre. After a couple of wet events, there is now a large marquee that is installed over Goyder Square to make it accessible even if it is raining. Again, we will be offering a sensory night with less flashing lights, loud noises and fewer people with sensory issues. And, of course the very popular Santa's Express will be there for a fun ride around Goyder Square. Keep a look out on council's website for more details.

I am looking forward to seeing you all at the PLSA Christmas Luncheon, and hope that you all have a great Christmas and Happy New Year.




