From 1 January 2025, renewing your licence will automatically include an extra 12 months. This applies whether you renew for one year or up to 10 years.

It is important to note, if your licence does not expire before 30 June 2025, you must apply to add the free 12 months through the MVR Quick Pay Website: https://mvr.nt.gov.au/mvrquickpay/.


